HE HAS NO BAD IN ME

" I will not say much more to you, for the prince of this world is coming. He has no hold over me, (John 14:30)

Paul tells us in Romans 8:19: "For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God (Romans 8:19). The whole chapter speaks about the Great Controversy between Christ and Satan, and how it will end: by the manifestation of the sons of God. Ellen White wrote: "When the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come." Christ is waiting with longing desire for the manifestation of Himself in His church. When the character of Christ shall be perfectly reproduced in His people, then He will come to claim them as His own. (COL 69). In 2 ST 294, we read:

- "Without perfection of character no one can enter the pearly gates of the city of God, for if, with all our imperfections, we were permitted to enter that city, there would soon be in heaven a second rebellion. We must first be tried and chosen, and found faithful and true. Upon the purification of our character rests our only hope of eternal life".

The problem is that without a total abiding in Christ, the Prince of this world will always have something in us to claim for Himself. "The yielding of self, surrendering all to the will of God, requires a struggle; but the soul must submit to God before it can be renewed in holiness". SC 43.3. In order to totally abide in Christ, we must surrender our will so that Christ can have the opportunity to live in us through His Holy Spirit.

Jesus is our model; He gave us the example by surrendering totally His life to the Father, living a life of daily dependency, and prayer, so the enemy trying Him then day by day might not have something in Him to claim for Himself. In His very final trying hours, He could say with assurance: "the prince of this world is coming; He has nothing in Me"-John 14:30".

The prince of this world is coming for the very last time in the history of this planet earth when the children of God will have to vindicate God's name in a way that the enemy will not have nothing in them to claim for himself. Unless we have learned during our lifetime to surrender all to Jesus, it will be difficult to do when life becomes challenging.

Will the world then see Jesus in you, when He will need you the most?
