Bible Study 2 *Jesus-Christ, The* *Merciful Redeemer*



On October 14th 1987, Jessica McClure, a 19-month-old baby girl fell into a 22 feet (6.7m) well in the Texas town of Midland. Shafts and tunnel had to be drilled to rescue the poor little girl. The rescue team who had only 48 hours to rescue her lest she die, worked intensively for 58 and half hour until she was finally found. She gained the attention of the whole world; her Hospital bill then cost 50,000 dollars.



Jesus said: "If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them wanders away, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others on the hills and go out to search for the one that is lost? And if he finds it, I tell you the truth, he will rejoice over it more than over the ninety-nine that didn't wander away!"
