YOUR LIBRARY, YOUR DESTINY.

"For by your words you will be acquitted, and by your words you will be condemned (Matthew 12:37-Kjv).

How do we know that God is faithful and true? Because everything He said, He does it (*"Then said the Lord unto me, Thou hast well seen: for I will hasten my word to perform it"* - Jeremiah 1:12-JKV). We trust God at His Word and promises.

<http://language.log.ldc.upenn.edu>). How important is this for the believers as far as their salvation is concerned?

In 2 Peter 3:10-11, the apostle wrote: *"But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, what manner of persons ought ye to be in all holy conversation and godliness"*-KJV. Does it mean that God will judge us by our words? Matthew 12:37 gives the answer. But why?

As we have seen earlier, God is true to His word; His word reveals His character of faithfulness. Our words also reveal the intentions and motives we have in the heart (Matthew 12:34). So God keeps a record of those words. In the preparation we are making for eternity, our words can speak loud on how we are walking with the Lord; let see what the Bible said about our words and actions:

- Malachi 3:16: *"Then those who feared the Lord talked with each other, and the Lord listened and heard. A scroll of remembrance was written in his presence concerning those who feared the Lord and honored his name"*-NIV.
- Psalm 56:8 - *You keep track of all my sorrows. You have collected all my tears in your bottle. You have recorded each one in your book"*-NLT.
- Psalm 139:16 – *"You saw me before I was born. Every day of my life was recorded in your book. Every moment was laid out before a single day had passed"*-NLT.

All our words and actions God will bring into judgment, on the day He has set, on the day no one will escape (Acts 17:31, 2 Corinthians 5:10), so we may give an account of them (Ecclesiastes 12:14; Romans 14:12).

If a one hundred pages of a book contains approximately 22,300 words, we can do the math to see how many books we have in the library of our life

that God can use to judge our character. In fact, it is not God who judges us; He simply makes a display of what we have inside of us.

What do you have in your daily prayers, daily conversations? What is the content of your speech in these last hours of probation? Remember, your words loudly reveal, your motives and the intentions of your heart (Psalm 19:14). What do you have in your library? Is there anything you need to erase? The blood of Jesus can help you have a clean record (Psalm 51:7). Do you want to have a clean library? The Spirit of God can help you keep your tongue from evil – (Psalm 34:13).

“Who may ascend into the hill of the Lord? Or who may stand in His holy place? He who has clean hands and a pure heart” (Psalm 24:4)-NKJV. “A good man brings good things out of the good stored up in his heart, and an evil man brings evil things out of the evil stored up in his heart. For the mouth speaks what the heart is full of” - Luke 6:45-NIV).

To see the face of our Savior in glory, we are to have a pure heart. The words of our mouth will testify of who has a pure heart.

May the words of mouth be acceptable in the sight of the most holy God, so we might be able to stand on the day of His appearing to see His face not in shame, but in righteousness. Amen!
