WHO SUFFERS WHEN I SIN?

If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it." (Genesis 4:7)

Who suffered when I sin? As Man went against God command in the garden of Eden, he could no longer stand His presence. As he heard the sound of God walking in the cool of the day, he hid from His presence because he was afraid. Because of that disobedience, there was accusation, resentment, animosity, regret, fear of the unknown, shame in the life of Adam and his wife.
