Questions: How will you exercise your free will? Will you submit it to God and live a happy life? Or will you exercise it for a self destruction and perish at last?






Free will: Definition

Free will is defined as the ability to make choices without constraints or restrictions. The end result of exercising free will is a selfish and self-centered life; the consequences of a selfishness and self centered life go beyond the individual himself and extend to his surroundings.
